Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

___:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Circle Up

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

2. Bible Story: The Tower of Babel

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: I Can Obey!

Say This: The people in our story today chose not to obey God. Because of that, God made their big towers really little. He later made a way for Jesus to come and help us to obey!

Let's play a fun game! I'm going to ask you to do something, and you can practice obeying!

Do This: Have the kids mimic you by displaying the following actions:

"Can you make a BIG TOWER with your hands reaching high to the sky like this? Great job obeying!

Can you touch your nose? Great job obeying!"

Continuing with the following ideas (and any others you can think of!): Can you – meow like a kitten, spin around, blink your eyes, say "hello!", pray to Jesus, etc.?

The Point: I can obey God!

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to obey you. Amen."
