



## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song**

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

### **\_\_:25 Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

### **\_\_:35 Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# Group Time Guide

**Supplies Needed:** Well Story Picture

## 1. Circle Up

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

## 2. Bible Story: Isaac's Story

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Well Builders!

**Say This:** The Philistines were jealous of Isaac. That means that they wanted what he had SO much that they would rather take it from him than let him have it. So they took away his water. But did Isaac get angry and fight? NO! He forgave them and dug more wells to get more water! He decided to be KIND! We can be kind too with God's help! Let's play a fun game! Can you show me your pretend hammers? We are going to build some wells!

**Do This:** Take one of the pictures of the well from today's story pictures and place it somewhere in the room. Have the kids go to the picture and pretend to build a well (each kid can hammer the picture once). (*"Everyone get your hammers out and pound pound pound! Look at this well!"*) Then, say *"Oh no! The Philistines broke our well! Should we get angry? No! Let's be KIND! We can build a new well over here!"* Take your well picture to a different part of the room and repeat. Do this as many times as the kids want.

Finish by saying *"Great job practicing being kind! God helps us to be kind!"*

**The Point:** God can help me to be kind!

## 4. Prayer

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to forgive others and to be kind. Amen."
