## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

## \_\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

# \_\_:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

## \_\_:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

# **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves, match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.

# **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Bible story picture of the Promised Land, tape (optional)

#### 1. Circle Up

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

### 2. Bible Story: Moses in the Wilderness

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Super Spies

**Say This**: In our story today, there were some big and scary people in the land, and so God's people ran away instead of trusting God! But Joshua and Caleb trusted God because they knew He would always be with them – and that was the better choice! We can choose to trust God too! Even when we are scared, God is always with us! Let's act out our story to remind us that we can trust God!

**Do This**: Have the kids all stand on one side of the room. Place the Bible Story picture of the Promised Land (with the scary men) on the other side of the room (preferably on a table or on the wall). Have the kids QUIETLY and SLOWLY tiptoe from their side of the room to the other as they "spy" on the land. Once they get to the picture of the Promised Land, say "Ah! Oh no! There are BIG men here! Let's run away!" And have the kids QUICKLY go back to the other side of the room to safety. Then say, "Let's be like Joshua and be BRAVE! Remember, we can trust God! Let's march back to the other side of the room because God is with us!" Have the kids MARCH to the picture again and once there, have them repeat after you, "I CAN TRUST GOD NO MATTER WHAT!" (Repeat as desired, using other fears [i.e. storms, the dark, monsters, etc.] as examples to walk towards/run away from, remembering that we can trust God!)

The Point: "I can trust God no matter what!"

### 4. Prayer

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to remember that we can trust You no matter what. Amen."
