



## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song**

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

### **\_\_:25 Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

### **\_\_:35 Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# Group Time Guide

**Supplies Needed:** Blue plastic tablecloth

## 1. Circle Up

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

## 2. Bible Story: Moses and the Exodus

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Parting the Red Sea

**Say This:** Moses trusted God a lot! He trusted God when he was sad because he hurt someone, he trusted God when Pharaoh wouldn't let his people go, and he trusted God when he was scared because he was being chased into a sea of water! God ALWAYS had a plan, and He has a plan for us too! We can always trust in God's plan! Let's play a fun game!

**Do This:** Have everyone sit in the middle of the room and lay the tablecloth on the floor.

*"Let's pretend this tablecloth is the sea in our story! Oh no! We can't get through! Let's trust in God's plan! Can you say, 'I TRUST GOD'?"*

When kids say "I trust God", lift the tablecloth so there is a space under it that the kids can walk through! Allow them to go through one at a time, and each time they do, say "I can trust God!". Repeat as desired.

**The Point:** I can trust in God's plan!

## 4. Prayer

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to trust in Your plan. Amen."
