



## **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Charades cards.

## 1. Time to Talk

**Look Up and Read**: Romans 12:10. In this verse, we're told to outdo each other in showing honor and love.

- Has someone ever thrown you a party? What was the party for?
- If someone asked you what "worship" was, what would you tell them? (Mention that worship can mean celebrating who God is.)
- What are some reasons we could celebrate someone else? (When they do something good, for just being our friend.)
- If you chose to encourage someone tomorrow, what are some things you could do? (Write a note, send a card, make a nice gift for them, say something kind about them.)

**Do This**: Pray with the kids. Thank God for loving us and ask Him to help you see reasons to celebrate.

## 2. Activity

Say This: Since we're talking about celebrating today, let's play a party game!

**Do This**: Play a game of charades! Bring a kid who wants to act out one of the cards to the front of the group and show them one of the cards. If they don't know what's on the card, show them a different one. You may read it quietly to them if they can't read it. Then, they act out what's on the card, for the others to guess! When someone guesses correctly, they are the next actor. Try to give every kid a chance to act out a card, if they want to.

**Discuss**: Who is someone each of us could celebrate this week, whether it's writing them a nice card, or throwing them a small party?
