**Do This:** During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Welcome everyone, let's get started! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.



*(Auto advance)* Elevate Slide and Underscore

Series Title Slide: A New Frontier and clear audio

We're in a series today called "A New Frontier." Our lives can feel like an adventure. We face tough challenges, have to work with other people, and usually have to work to get where we want to be. In this series, we'll be finding out how God can lead us every day of our lives.

If you're ever traveling with a group of people, and someone got hurt, what would you do? You'd have to stop and help them. It's what we want them to do for us, so it's what

we need to do for them, too. The same thing is true in life. We need to think about what's best for others. But what does that look like? That's what we're talking about today.

We'll learn more about that in a bit, but let's get started with a game called "Freeze Tag."



Game Title Slide: "Freeze Tag"

This game is like "freeze tag, except there is only one person who can tag others. That person has a blue pool noodle. If you get tagged by the blue pool noodle, you have to freeze. There will be someone else, though, who has a red pool noodle. If you get tagged by the red pool noodle, you can move again.

**Do This:** Give a red pool noodle to one kid, and a blue pool noodle to another.

Ready, set, go!

**Do This:** Allow them to play for 4-5 minutes.

Ok, so fun! You can all un-freeze and come back to the middle.

You can all sit down and get ready to answer our question of the day!



Question of the Day Video



*(Auto Advance)* QOTD Slide: When is a time someone has helped you?

Our question of the day is: When is a time someone has helped you? Turn to someone near you and tell them about it! Make sure to listen to a time someone else has helped them, too.

**Do This:** Allow kids to talk for about 30 seconds.

**Know This:** You could share briefly about a time you needed help.
