## Opening Song and Welcome

(Roll when directed) Elevate Opener

**Do This**: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Welcome everyone, let's get started! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.



My name is \_\_\_\_\_, and I'm so excited to be here with all of you!

Elevate is an awesome place where we get to have fun and learn about God. It's also a place where we show respect. We <u>respect the leaders</u> in here by listening and following their instructions. We <u>respect others</u> by being kind and keeping our hands to ourselves. And we <u>respect the room</u> by being safe, and not damaging anything. Showing respect like that helps us all have an awesome time.

### Team Time 14:00



We're in a series today called "A New Frontier." Our lives can feel like an adventure. We face tough challenges, have to work with other people, and usually have to work to get where we want to be. In this series, we'll be finding out how God can lead us every day of our lives.

On every adventure, we have choices to make. Today, we're talking about the most important choice of our lives. We'll learn more about that in a bit, but let's get started with a game called "Ball-Pit Roundup." **Know This**: Ahead of time, make sure there is a circle taped on the floor for each group, and that the group flags are placed by the circles. Game Title Slide: "Ball-Pit Roundup" In this game, there will be a lot of ball pit balls dumped on the floor. Using only your feet, you have to round as many up as you can, into the circles by your group flag. You can only touch them with your feet. Also, you can't kick the balls out of other group's circles, your feet can't go inside their circles at all. If a ball rolls out of their circle, you can touch it, though. Head on over to your group flag and get ready to play! **Do This**: Allow kids to get into their groups. Ready, set, go! **Do This**: Allow them to play for 4-5 minutes. Fun Game Music! Ok, so fun! Group leaders, can you count how many balls are inside your group's circle? **Do This**: Allow group leaders to count and announce a winner! Game Title Slide: "Ball-Pit Roundup" and clear audio Great job, everyone. You can all sit down and get ready to answer our question of the day! Question of the Day Video

(Auto Advance) QOTD Slide: When is a time you've had to trust someone?

Our question of the day is: When is a time you've had to trust someone? "Trust" means believing someone, like when you tell them a secret or let them borrow something that is important to you. Turn to someone near you and tell them about it! Make sure to listen to a time they trusted someone, too.

**Do This**: Allow kids to talk for about 30 seconds.

Know This: You could share briefly about a time you trusted someone.




**Do This**: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to discuss the question.

## Media Part 3: Application

I wonder what Josh and Beka have learned from all they've been doing today? Let's find out!



Every one of us can choose to follow God, right here, right now. That is the most important decision you will ever make!

### **Decision Time**

2:00

Maybe you've already made that choice and decided to follow Jesus with your whole life. If that's where you're at, you can do what Saul did in our Bible story. He wanted to tell as many people as he could about how his life was changed by Jesus. We can tell people about Jesus, too!

Maybe you still have questions about following Jesus. You want to know more about what it means, or why people follow Jesus. I want you to know, that is totally ok. Your questions are so important to God, and I want you to know that this is a safe place to ask all of your questions. Talk to one of the leaders in here, we would love to listen to you, and talk about any questions or worries you have.

Maybe, though, today is the day you want to make the most important decision of your life, the choice to follow Jesus! If you want to make that choice, we're going to talk to God in a moment, and you can tell Him you want to make Him the leader of your life. You'll tell God that you are sorry for the things you've done that you know are wrong, that you believe in Jesus, and that you want him to be your leader, savior, and friend forever.

If you want to make that choice for the first time, you can talk to God with me right now. You should know that just saying these words isn't what changes our lives, what matters is really making the decision to follow Jesus. I'm going to have all of us bow our heads and close our eyes. If you want to follow Jesus, you can repeat this after me. You can say it out loud or in your mind, God hears you either way.

**Do This**: Say the following prayer word-for-word, pausing after each line to allow kids to repeat it after you.

God, thank you for loving me.
I am sorry for doing things
That I know are wrong.
I believe that Jesus is your son.
I believe that he died on the cross,
Took my punishment,
And came back to life,
So that I can be forgiven.
Jesus, I ask you now
To be my leader,
Savior,
And friend forever.
I choose to follow you.
In Jesus' name, amen.

Congratulations!

If you just decided to follow Jesus for the first time, congratulations! I am so excited for every one of you, and there is something I want you to have.

**Do This**: Hold up the Following Jesus book.

This is a book all about Following Jesus. It will help you get started and tell you more about what living with Jesus as your leader means. We'd love to give you this and celebrate with you, so if you just made that choice for the first time, you can follow me! Everyone else, you can stay right here and you'll get to sing and worship God.

**Do This**: Lead the kids who just made a decision to a place where you can lead them in a "decision talk." Make sure someone is ready to lead worship after you leave the stage.
