

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Introductions

Circle Up: Have the Kid-Os wave at each other and then sit down in a circle. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

2. Discussion Questions

- What did God tell Abraham to do? (Move to a new place.)
- How did Abraham choose to "follow" God? (Listened to Him and obeyed Him.)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Give kids instructions and have them follow you. You could say things like: Raise your hand, jump up and down, walk to one side of the room, run in place, spin around, walk back to the middle of the room, sit down, and clap your hands.

The Point: Abraham followed God! That meant He trusted God and did what God wanted Him to do. We can follow God today, too.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Psalm 121:1-2 – "I look up to the mountains. Where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord. He is the Maker of heaven and earth." **Big Idea**: I can choose to follow God.

Do This: Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to follow you. Amen."
