Have you ever gone on an adventure? You might learn new things, overcome obstacles, and explore new places along the way. Living a life following God can be an adventure, too! In this series, we'll take a look at people in the Bible and the adventure they had following God.

Lesson 1: Get Ready for an Adventure!

When you go out on an adventure, it's important to be prepared. This week, we'll see how God prepared Noah so he would be ready for the flood.

Lesson 2: Choose Your Leader

On any adventure, it is important to choose a leader who knows where to go and the best way to get there. God is the best leader we could ever have to guide us through life. This week, we'll take a look at Abraham's story and how he chose to follow God into a new land.

Lesson 3: Never Go Alone

Adventures can be full of ups and downs. It's important to have someone who will stick with us through it all. This week, we'll learn that God is always with us no matter what we go through.

Lesson 4: Overcome Obstacles

At times during an adventure, we'll run into obstacles and wonder what to do. This week, we'll hear the story of Moses and the huge obstacle that was in his way. We'll discover that we can do hard things with God by our side.

Lesson 5: Serve One Another

On any adventure, it is important to help other people along the way. That's exactly what some friends did for Moses when they were in the middle of a battle. This week, we'll discover that all of us can find a way to serve others.

Lesson 6: Don't Give Up

When things get tough on the trail, it can be tempting to give up. This week, we'll hear the story of Joshua and how he showed perseverance when it could have been easy to stop.

Lesson 7: Trust Your Leader

On any adventure, it's important to have a leader you can trust. This week, Gideon will discover that he can trust God to lead him.

Lesson 8: Work as a Team

As we adventure through life, it's important to have some good friends who will stay by our side. This week, we'll see how Ruth was a good friend and learn how we can be a good friend to others.

Lesson 9: Be Brave

On our adventure, we might need to do something courageous that we've never done before. This week, we'll learn how we can be brave, just like David was brave as he fought against Goliath.

Lesson 10: Make Wise Choices

During an adventure, there are often choices to be made. Which way should we go? How are we going to get there? A man named Solomon knew how important it was to have wisdom and this week we'll learn how we can make wise choices.

Lesson 11: Ask for Help

Sometimes we can find ourselves in a tricky situation. Who do we go to when we need help? Nehemiah ran into some trouble as he was building a wall, but he knew he could ask God to help him. This week, we'll learn that we can talk to God and ask him for help, too!

Lesson 12: Take the Next Step

On an adventure, we need to keep taking the next step and following our guide. This week, we'll discover that God had a plan for Esther's life, and he has a plan for each one of us, too. We can follow God wherever he leads us!

Lesson 13: Celebrate the Victories

When an adventure is over, we can look back and celebrate all that we did together. David was a man in the Bible who went on a lot of adventures with God. This week, we'll learn that David wrote songs to worship God and celebrate what God had done in his life.

Introduction and Rules

Welcome everyone! My name is _____, and I'm so excited to see each and every one of you! During our time together, we'll get to sing a couple songs, hear an awesome story, and go on a super fun adventure together! Before we do any of that, there are three important things for you to remember.

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: *When I'm talking you are listening!*

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! On the count of three, let's practice our very best listening. Ready? 1, 2, 3!

Rule #2: *Keep your hands and feet to yourself!*

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: *Stay in your spot!*

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Great job listening to our rules. The rules are really great because they can help us learn and have lots of fun while we're here.

Big Idea

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. This week, we are starting a brand-new series called "Adventure Awaits!" Have you ever gone on an adventure? You might learn new things, overcome obstacles, or explore new trails. Living a life following God can feel like an adventure, too.

Today, we're going to go on an adventure together! To get started, we're going to need a backpack with some supplies. Let's take a look inside to find out what we're bringing with us on our adventure today!

Do This: Show Kid-Os the backpack and take item images out one by one. Set each item on aboard where the kids can see them during the lesson.

Let's see, we have a rope, a canteen, and a pool floatie. We'll need all of these things for our adventure today. There's also a mystery item. I wonder what it could be?

Let's get started by putting on our backpacks and marching over to the Big Idea. Can you do that with me?

Do This: Have kids put on imaginary backpacks and march in place with you.



Big Idea Jingle



(Auto advance) Big Idea Slide: I can obey God.

Awesome job! We made it! The Big Idea is, “I can obey God.” Obeying God means doing what He says is right. Let’s practice the big idea together. I’ll say a part first and you can repeat after me. I can, I CAN. Obey God, OBEY GOD. Great job! Alright, now let’s say it all together!

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Growling tiger, soaring plane, quiet sleeping.**

Know This: These are the Big Idea actions: (Place your hands in front of your face, palms out, then move them down in a rainbow motion) The Big Idea. (Point at self) I can, (march in place) obey God.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea! You can all sit down.

That Big Idea is so important, we’re going to say it several times during our adventure. Whenever we get through one of the obstacles on our path, we’ll say the Big Idea!

Bible Adventure

Next, we get to learn more by going on a Bible Adventure, but look! There’s a big pit in our path!

Which one of our items can reach all the way across a big pit? The rope, the canteen, or the floaties?

Do This: Pause and let kids answer.

Yes, the rope! We have to walk very carefully across the canyon on our rope. Can you pretend to walk with me?

Do This: Pretend to tightrope walk across the stage. Encourage the kids to walk in place as well.

Whew! We made it! Let's practice our Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN OBEY GOD. Awesome job! Now, let's sit down and get ready for a Bible Adventure!



Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God. There are also true stories in the Bible about people who had some adventures while they followed God! Today, we get to read about someone who got some very special, and very unusual instructions from God.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: Noah

Long, long ago, there was a time when almost everyone on earth was only doing wrong things, all the time. They hurt other people and were very unkind. Only Noah and his family followed God. One day, God told Noah to do something very unexpected. He told him to build a big boat, called an ark.



Picture 2: Noah building the ark

God said a huge flood was coming, and he had a plan to keep Noah and his family safe. Noah didn't ask God a ton of questions, he didn't try to find another way, he didn't wait awhile and then do what God wanted. Noah did what God said, right away, and with a good attitude.



Picture 3: Animals getting onto the ark.

Noah and his family worked very hard and finished the ark! Then, God told them to do something else. They had to get two of every kind of animal onto the ark, and pack enough food for all of them! Right after everyone got on board the ark, it started to rain.



Picture 4: The Flood

It rained, and rained, and rained some more, for forty whole days and nights. When it stopped, as far as Noah and his family could see, there was only water! Then, God sent a huge wind to dry up all the water. And for months, Noah and his family waited and waited for all the water to dry.



Picture 5: The Rainbow

One day, though, the water dried up, and Noah and his family left the ark. Then, God showed them a rainbow in the sky and promised to never let a flood that big happen ever again. Noah and his family were so glad they obeyed God!

Great listening, Kid-Os! I am sure Noah and his family were thankful that they did what God said, right away.

Next, we're going to head over to our Memory Verse, but it looks like there is something blocking our path.

We've got to cross a hot, dry desert! Let's start walking.

Do This: Walk in place.

Wow, I'm feeling warm, and kind of thirsty. Can one of the things in our backpack help? Should I use the canteen or the floatie?

Do This: Allow kids to answer.

Canteens hold water! Can you pretend to take a drink of water with me?

Do This: Pretend to take a drink of water together.

Way to go, Kid-Os! We made it across the desert! Now let's say our Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN OBEY GOD. Awesome job! You can sit down.

(Auto-advance) Psalm 121:1-2 – "I look up to the mountains. Where does my help come from? My help comes from the Lord. He is the Maker of heaven and earth."

Our Memory Verse comes from the Bible. This verse is all about how God made our world, and how He is always with us, ready to help us.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

When we obey God, we're letting Him lead us and help us, just like that verse is talking about. Let's practice saying that verse together!

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) Psalm 121:1-2. (Shade your eyes and look up) I look up to the mountains. (Shrug, palms up) Where does my help come from? (Point up) My help comes from the Lord. (Stretch high) He is the maker of heaven (touch the ground) and earth.

We made it! Let's say our Big Idea one more time. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN OBEY GOD. Great job! You can sit down, because now it's time to try out what we've been learning today and find out what it is by checking in with our friend, Kristen.
