

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Worship CD

1. Introductions

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a "thumbs up" when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

2. Discussion Questions

- How did David celebrate what God did in our Bible Adventure story? (He wrote songs to God and worshipped him.)
- What are some ways we can celebrate the things God has done in our life? (Worship God, say thank you to God, remember prayers God has answered, etc.)

3. Hands-On Option

Say This: It is good for us to remember what God has done in our life and celebrate those things. That is one way we worship God.

Do This: Play a game of "Freeze Dance" to an upbeat worship song (Ex. Hosanna Rock on Little Praise Party CD). When the song is playing, the kids should dance. Pause the song every once in a while. When the song is paused, everyone should freeze.

The Point: We can worship God by thanking him and celebrating all that he has done!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Joshua 1:9 – "Be strong and brave. Do not be terrified. Do not lose hope. I am the Lord your God. I will be with you everywhere you go."

Big Idea: I can celebrate what God has done.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to remember and celebrate all that you've done in our lives. Amen.
