Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Wisdom Stories

1. Introductions

Circle Up: Have each Kid-O give you a high five and then sit down in a circle. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer.

2. Discussion Questions

- If you had one wish, what would you wish for?
- What did Solomon ask for in the Bible Adventure? (Wisdom)
- What does it mean to be wise? (To know the difference between right and wrong, to make good choices)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Read the wisdom stories one at a time to the kids. Have them do the actions listed on the card to show you if that was a wise choice or not.

Say This: The Bible tells us that God gives us wisdom when we ask him for it. God can help us know the difference between right and wrong and make wise choices.

The Point: God can help us make wise choices each day.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Joshua 1:9 – “Be strong and brave. Do not be terrified. Do not lose hope. I am the Lord your God. I will be with you everywhere you go.”

Big Idea: I can make wise choices.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us make wise choices each day. Amen.”
