Series at a Glance for Kid-O-Deo (continued)

Lesson 1: Follow Jesus' Example

When Jesus lived on the earth, he asked people to “follow him!” Jesus showed us an example of how to live and how to love other people well. This week, we’ll discover how we can build up our faith as we let Jesus lead and guide us each day.

Lesson 2: Read the Bible

The Bible is the greatest book ever! Reading the Bible can help us grow in our faith and learn more about God. This week, we’ll hear what Paul tells Timothy about the importance of the Bible.

Lesson 3: Connect in Community

When the church began, the followers of Jesus spent a lot of time together praying, sharing meals, and encouraging one another. Our faith can grow stronger when we spend time with others who follow Jesus.

Lesson 4: Pray

One way we can build up our faith is by talking to God. This week, we’ll hear the story of Peter and John. They prayed for God’s power to help them do the important work of sharing Jesus’ story.

Lesson 5: Serve

In Bible times washing feet was a job for only the lowest servants, but that’s what Jesus did for his disciples. This week, we’ll discover how serving others is a part of following Jesus and growing in our faith.

Lesson 6: Choose to Follow Jesus

Jesus came into the world, died on a cross, and rose again to save us and take the punishment for every wrong thing we have done. Jesus loves each one of us so much and we can choose to follow him. We can grow strong in our faith with Jesus by our side!

Lesson 7: Live Generously

All of us have something we can share with others. It could be our toys, time, kind words, or something else. This week, we’ll hear how Jesus used what a young boy had to offer to do something incredible.

Lesson 8: Worship God

Paul and Silas had some difficult things happen to them. Even when they were thrown in jail, they continued to worship God by praying and singing to him. We can worship God no matter what!

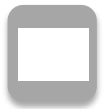

Introduction and Rules

Welcome everyone! My name is _____, and I'm super excited to see each and every one of you! During our time together, we'll get to sing a couple fun songs, learn a memory verse, and hear an awesome story. Before we do any of that, there are three important things for you to remember.

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! On the count of three, let's practice our very best listening. Ready? 1, 2, 3!

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Big Idea

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. We are in a series called "Build it Up!" When you build something, like a snowman, you put lots of different pieces together to make it. This series is all about the different things we can "build" into our lives that will help us grow in our faith and get to know Jesus better.

During our time together, our forest friend Rocky Raccoon is going to be building something out of snow or ice. To find out what it is, we have to finish each part of the lesson.

Let's get started by practicing our "Big Idea." That's the super important thing we're learning about today!



Big Idea Jingle



(Auto advance) Big Idea Slide: I can read the Bible to learn about God.

The Big Idea is, “I can read the Bible to learn about God.” Kid-Os, the Bible is so important because it is full of words from God. We can learn more about God and get to know him better when we read the Bible. Let’s stand up and practice the big idea. I’ll say a part first and you can repeat after me. I can read the Bible, I CAN READ THE BIBLE. To learn about God, TO LEARN ABOUT GOD. Great job! Alright, now let’s say it all together!

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: falling snowflake, growling bear, flying airplane.**

Know This: These are the Big Idea actions: (Place your hands in front of your face, palms out, then move them down in a rainbow motion) The Big Idea. (Put hands together and open like a book) I can read the Bible (point up) to learn about God.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea! You can all sit down.

That Big Idea is so important, we’re going to say it several times today. Whenever you hear this sound of jingle bells, it’s time to say our big idea!



Big Idea Jingle Bells

You can say it and still do the actions while sitting in your spot. Let’s practice!



Big Idea Jingle Bells

Let’s say the Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN READ THE BIBLE TO LEARN ABOUT GOD. Great job, Kid-Os!

Now, let’s check in with Rocky to see what he has been building so far!

Series Title Slide: Build it Up!

Rocky is off to a great start! Next, we get to learn more about the Bible by going on a Bible Adventure.



Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories about people who loved God in the Bible too! Today, we get to read a story about why the Bible is so important.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: Paul traveling with Timothy

Paul was a man who loved Jesus and traveled around telling other people about him. A young man named Timothy heard Paul speak and decided to follow Jesus. Timothy grew strong in his faith, and Paul invited him to come on his trips to share the good news of Jesus with others.



Picture 2: Timothy as a pastor at a church.

Even though Timothy was young and didn't have a lot of experience, Paul saw that he loved Jesus and wanted to learn how to be a leader in the church. Eventually, Timothy became the pastor of a church. Being the pastor was difficult, so Paul wrote Timothy a letter to encourage him and to remind him of some important things.

One of the things that Paul wrote about in his letter was how important the Bible was. He told Timothy that God is the one who told the authors of the Bible what to write. That is why we can trust the Bible. It is God's words. Paul also said that the Bible teaches us, corrects our mistakes, and shows us what is right. When we read the Bible, it can help us know what God wants us to do.

Paul finished his letter to Timothy by telling him to not give up when things get hard. Timothy should keep on telling others about Jesus and doing all of the things that God wants him to do.

(Auto-advance) Memory Verse: Colossians 2:7 – “Build yourselves up in Him. Grow strong in what you believe.”

Our Memory Verse comes from the Bible. This one is all about growing strong in our faith in Jesus.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

Kid-Os, one way our faith can grow stronger is by reading the Bible. When we spend time with God by reading our Bible, we get to know Him better.

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) Colossians 2:7. (Stack your fists on top of one another like you’re building) Build yourselves up (point up) in Him. (Flex arm muscles) Grow strong in what you believe.

Super job practicing your Memory Verse, Kid-Os! Let’s check back in and see what Rocky has been building!
