



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Hearts

1. Circle Up

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

2. Bible Story: Paul and Timothy – 2 Tim 3:17

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Heart Scavenger Hunt

Say This: The Bible is an amazing book that helps us learn about God. One important thing we learn in the Bible is how much God loves us. Can you say this with me? (Have kids repeat after you.) “God loves me!”

Do This: Go on a heart scavenger hunt! Kid-Os can remain seated and look around the room for hearts that will be taped to the wall. When a child finds one of the hearts, they should point to it. Each time a heart is found, you can lead the group in repeating the phrase “God loves me!”

The Point: Reading the Bible can help us get to know God better. One of the most important things we can learn is how much God loves us.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to learn more about you by reading the Bible. Amen.”
