Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Sharing Stories Sheet

1. Introductions

Circle Up: Have each Kid-O give you a high five and then sit down in a circle. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer.

2. Discussion Questions

- How did the people in the first church help others? (By sharing the things they had.)
- Who is someone you could share with today?

Repeatable Phrases: “I can share.” “Sharing is fun!”

3. Activity

Do This: Read the “sharing stories sheet” with the kids. For each story, have the kids show you a thumbs-up if the person in the story shared, and a thumbs-down if they didn’t share.

The Point: Sharing helps us make friends with others, and be good friends to them, too. We can all have so much more fun when we choose to share.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Hebrews 10:24- Let us consider how we can stir up one another to love. Let us help one another to do good works.

Big Idea: I can share with anyone, sharing helps us all have fun!

Do This: Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to share with others. Amen.”
