

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Respect Stories

1. Introductions

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

2. Discussion Questions

- What does the word "respect" mean? (To listen and obey, especially our grown-ups.)
- Why do you think respecting our grown-ups is so important?

3. Activity

Do This: Read the "Respect Stories" to the kids one at a time. Have kids put their thumb up if the story shows respect and their thumb down if it doesn't.

The Point: When we show respect for our grown-ups, they help us stay safe and make wise choices.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: Hebrews 10:24- Let us consider how we can stir up one another to love. Let us help one another to do good works.

Big Idea: Respect means listening and obeying, too, when my grown-ups say what to do.

Do This: Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to respect our grown-ups. Amen."
