

# **Group Time Guide**

**Supplies Needed: Choosing Loyalty Stories** 

### 1. Introductions

**Circle Up:** As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

#### 2. Discussion Questions

- What does it mean to be "loyal"? (To do what's best for our friends and family, no matter what.)
- Do you know anyone who has been loyal? How?

## 3. Activity

**Do This**: Read each of the "Choosing Loyalty" stories and ask Kid-Os to think about what the character in each story could do to be loyal to their friend, family, or to God.

**The Point**: All of us want friends who are loyal, who care about us, and are always there for us. The way we treat others, and the things we say about them, even when they're not around, those are all times we can practice being loyal.

## 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

**Do This**: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

**Memory Verse**: Hebrews 10:24- Let us consider how we can stir up one another to love. Let us help one another to do good works.

**Big Idea**: Loyalty means doing what's right, for my friends and family, day or night.

**Big Idea**: Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This**: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be loyal friends and family members. Amen."
