



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: A toy.

1. Circle Up

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

2. Bible Story: The Ten Commandments

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Respect

Say This: Respect means listening to our grown-ups and being kind. We can show respect to other people, and to the things around us. Can you tell me if the things I'm doing are respectful or not?

Do This: Hold up a toy. Ask:

- Would it be respectful if I threw this toy into the wall? (No.)
- Would it be respectful if I played with it nicely? (Yes.)
- Would it be respectful if I shared it with someone? (Yes.)

Do This: Set down the toy. Ask:

- Would it be respectful if my grown-ups asked me to do something and I yelled "No!" (No.)
- Would it be respectful if I listened and did what they asked me to right away? (Yes.)

The Point: Respect is an important part of being a good friend and family member.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to respect others. Amen."
