



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Blocks

1. Circle Up

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

2. Bible Story: The Log and the Speck

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option:

Say This: Jesus told that story to show people that they shouldn't be mean to others, Instead, they should do their best, and help others do their best, too.

Do This: Make a small stack of blocks but build them unevenly so they fall over.

Ask: What should I do? Should I get mad? (No.) Should I blame someone else, and say "It's your fault my blocks fell over"? (No.) Should I try again, and fix the mistake I made? (Yes.)

The Point: Making mistakes and getting things wrong is ok. We can fix it and try again! Jesus wanted us to focus on the things we can do, instead of getting mad at others.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to do our best and try again when we need to. Amen."
