



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Circle Up

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

2. Bible Story: Solomon's Words

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Say It Loud!

Say This: Solomon saw people using bad words, and people using good words. Let's try using some good words today! Repeat these words after me.

Do This: Say these words and have the Kid-Os repeat them. "You're great!" "I'm glad you're my friend." "Thank you." "You're amazing." "You're fun to be with." "I love you."

The Point: We can choose to use good words when we talk to our friends and families.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to use good words. Amen."
