





Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Disposable eye masks, masking tape.

1. Time to Talk

Look Up and Read: Psalm 62:7-8. These verses are about trusting God with everything.

- When is a time you tried something even though it scared you? Would you try it again?
- When is a time that someone else trusted you?
- Why do you think Josh and Beka might have to clean and do the unusual things they're doing?
- What do you think someone does when they "trust God"?

2. Activity

Say This: Trust means believing someone, following them, even when you're not sure what will happen. We sometimes trust other people, but the one we can always trust, no matter what, is God.

Do This: Ahead of time, tape out some paths on the floor, with several turns, and even a gap in the tape. Have the kids partner up and give each pair of kids an eye mask. Have one of them put on their mask. The other one must lead them down the path of the tape, using only their voice to give instructions. Once at the end, have them switch roles, and try again.

Discuss: Would you rather be the one giving the instructions or following the instructions? Why?

Discuss: What is one way we could show that we trust God this week? (Talk to Him, learn about Him, tell others about Him, choose to do what He says is right.)

The Point: We can trust God, no matter what happens, or where we are. We can always follow Him and do what He says is right.
