#### Lesson 1: September 11/12

(Roll when directed) Elevate Opener

**Do This**: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

Welcome everyone, let's get started! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.



(Auto advance) Elevate Slide and Underscore

Showing respect like that helps us all have an awesome time.

Series Title Slide: Cinematic and clear audio

We're in a series today called "Cinematic." The word "cinematic" means "like a movie," or like making a movie. A movie set is filled with people in all kinds of roles. Some are backstage, some are in the spotlight. Some people are directing, some are on a set for the first time. It's all those relationships that make the movie succeed or fail. In this series, we'll learn how we can have great relationships with others whether we are center-stage or behind the scenes.

Let's get started with a game called Race-Paper-Scissors.

Game Title Slide: Race-Paper-Scissors

We're setting up some paths on the floor, made out of tape. Your group is going to line up at one end of a path, with another group on the opposite side. One at a time, the first person in your group is going to go as far as they can on the path until they meet someone from the other group. You can only step on the marks, so you have to jump, not run. When you meet, you're going to play rock-paper- scissors, really fast. Just count one-two-three and on three pick rock, paper, or scissors. The one who loses has to get off the path right away and go to the back of their line. The other person can keep going down the path, but as soon as one person loses, the next person from your group should be ready to go from the starting line! The group that gets someone to the last step on the other team's end wins!

**Do This**: Make sure the group leaders know what to do and have the supplies to set up paths on the floor, each path 20 or more steps long. You could demonstrate this for the kids on-stage quickly, too.

**Know This**: While you are talking, leaders should create a path by taping dots or x symbols onto the floor (if it is not already created). There should be one path for every two groups who will be playing the game, and it should go straight across the room.

**Know This**: If a group actually manages to win the game with time left, they may play again. Groups should be 10-15 kids if possible. If you can play this game as a large group, only dividing the kids into two teams, you may. If you need to combine groups or have groups compete only against others from their own group, you may do that as well.

## You can go to your group's flag and meet your leaders there. I'll tell you when the first runners can start!

**Do This**: Allow kids to find their group's area and get lined up.


**Do This**: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to discuss the question.


I hope you had fun, and got to think more about what we should do when we feel like life is unfair. Next, we get to check in with The Elevate Show again! Take a look.
