Series Title Slide: Cinematic and clear audio

We're in a series today called "Cinematic." The word "cinematic" means "like a movie," or like making a movie. A movie set is filled with people in all kinds of roles. Some are backstage, some are in the spotlight. Some people are directing, some are on a set for the first time. It's all those relationships that make the movie succeed or fail. In this series, we'll learn how we can have great relationships with others whether we are center-stage or behind the scenes.

Let's get started with a game called Taking Sides.

Game Title Slide: Taking Sides

In this game, I'm going to show you two options. You have to pick which one you would prefer, by running to the side of the room that matches the option you'd choose.

Ready? Let's see our first option!



Unlimited French fries | Unlimited chocolate shakes (and fun game music!)

Would you rather have unlimited French fries or unlimited chocolate shakes? You've got ten seconds to pick a side!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Ok, you have another choice to make, let's check it out!

Live underwater | Live on the moon

Would you rather live underwater or on the moon? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Ok, you have another choice to make, let's check it out!

Not eat candy for a year | Not watch any shows for a year

Would you rather not eat candy for a year, or not watch any shows for a year? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Interesting answers! You have another choice to make, let's check it out!



Only be able to talk by singing | Only be able to move by dancing

Would you rather only be able to talk by singing, or only be able to move by dancing? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Both of those might be fun for a little while, but I'm not sure how long. You have another choice to make, let's check it out!

Eat broccoli flavored ice cream | Eat chicken flavored cookies

Would you rather eat broccoli flavored ice cream, or chicken flavored cookies? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Ok, you have another choice to make, let's check it out!



Have binocular vision | Have microscopic vision

Would you rather have binocular vision, so you can see things far away, or microscopic vision, so you can see tiny things? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Ok, you have another choice to make, let's check it out!

Have an elephant-sized cat | Have a cat-sized elephant

Would you rather have an elephant-sized cat or a cat-sized elephant? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the next option.

Ok, you have one final choice to make, let's check it out!

Sneeze whenever someone says "cookie" | Cry whenever someone says "potato."

Would you rather sneeze whenever someone says "cookie," or cry whenever someone says "potato"? Pick your answer!

Do This: Allow kids to pick their sides but move on within ten seconds to the end of the game.
