#### Lesson 1: September 11/12

## **Opening Song and Welcome**

### (Roll when directed) Elevate Opener

**Do This**: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.

# Welcome everyone, let's get started! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.

(Auto advance) Elevate Slide and Underscore

Elevate is an awesome place where we get to have fun and learn about God. It's also a place where we show respect. We <u>respect the leaders</u> in here by listening and following their instructions. We <u>respect others</u> by being kind and keeping our hands to ourselves. And we <u>respect the room</u> by being safe, and not damaging anything. Showing respect like that helps us all have an awesome time.

Series Title Slide: Cinematic and clear audio

We're in a series today called "Cinematic." The word "cinematic" means "like a movie," or like making a movie. A movie set is filled with people in all kinds of roles. Some are backstage, some are in the spotlight. Some people are directing, some are on a set for the first time. It's all those relationships that make the movie succeed or fail. In this series, we'll learn how we can have great relationships with others whether we are center-stage or behind the scenes.

#### Let's get started with a game called Hachi Pachi CoSiki!

**Know This:** This game is pronounced ha-chee paw-chee co-see-kee. Kids may know it from playing the game at school.

Game Title Slide: Hachi Pachi CoSiki! (and fun game music!)


The goal in this game is to do things without the person in the middle noticing you. In a minute, we're going to get into small groups. Once we're there, you'll stand in a circle and put one person in the middle. That person will cover their eyes until your small group leader picks someone else to start moving their body in a way that the rest of the group copies. That person might start snapping their fingers, slapping their thighs, making siren noises, or making a repeated rhythmic motion—whatever creative idea they come up with. Everyone in the circle immediately copies them, even when they decide to change what they're doing. The challenge in the game is that the person in the middle of the circle is trying to guess who is setting the pattern for the group... so you don't want to give away who it is!

**Do This:** Divide up the room into small groups (the same groups that kids will meet with later on in the hour) and have them each form a circle with one kid standing in the middle. You may need to combine some groups if you don't have at least 7 people in each of them.

**Do This:** Walk around the room to help Small Group Leaders re-explain and coordinate the game if needed.

**Know this:** The guesser in the middle will eventually identify the leader. Once they do, have them trade places, and select a new leader.

**Know this:** Sometimes kids will go down the line and make guesses rapid-fire, working off the process of elimination instead of observing changes in the group's behavior. It's okay to stop them and say they need to make actual guesses instead of simply just going through everyone in the group.



Great job, everyone! You can find a spot to sit, but get ready, next up is our question of the day.



Question of the Day Video



(Auto Advance) QOTD Slide: When is a time someone helped you?

Our question today is: When is a time someone helped you when you? What did they do? Maybe they helped you with a problem at school or showed you how to do something. Whatever it is, turn to someone near you and tell them about it! Make sure to listen to their answer, too.

**Do This**: Allow kids to talk for about 30 seconds.

**Know This**: The goal here is for kids to make connections with the other kids they are sitting next to in order to build relationships and make it possible to have deeper conversations later in the hour. Therefore, it's preferable to let kids chat with one another instead of calling on a few kids for to share their answers with the whole group.

Know This: You can share your answer briefly, too!

All of us have had other people who helped us, and that feels great, but God challenges us to think even further. Since there are so many people who help us, how could we help others?
