Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Scenario Page

1. Time to Talk

Look Up and Read: Ephesians 4:31-32- These verses are about responding kindly to others.

- What is something kind someone has done for you?
- How does it feel if someone is unkind to you?
- Why did those verses say we should be kind and forgive others? (Because that's what Jesus did for us.)

Ask: What is going great right now? Is there something that's not going great right now?

Pray: Talk to God, mentioning things the kids talked about if appropriate.

2. Activity

Do This: Read through the scenarios on the page, talking about ways you might respond to each of the situations. Discuss how each response listed might be kind or unkind, and how you think it would affect the situation.

The Point: We can respond kindly, even when we feel hurt or angry. If someone has hurt us, won't stop when we ask them to, or is being very unkind, we should tell an adult about what is happening, but we can still choose to be kind with our words and actions to that person at the same time.
