



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Whiteboard, dry erase markers, eraser. Pictionary cards.

1. Time to Talk

Look Up and Read: Ephesians 2:10. This verse is about how every one of us was made by God for a purpose.

- What are some things people "design" or create? (Buildings, artwork, music.)
- What is something you have made that you are really proud of?
- Why did that verse say God made us? (to belong to Him/Jesus, and to do good.)
- Can you name three people who are different from you? What does this verse mean for them? (They are made by God, too! God wants them to follow Him.)

Ask: What is something going great right now? What is something that is difficult right now?

Pray: Talk to God, mentioning relevant things that came up in your discussion.

2. Activity

Do This: Choose three kids to draw on the whiteboard. Give each of them a marker.

Say This: This game is like Pictionary, except these three can only draw three straight lines at a time. The first person will come up, draw three straight lines, and then have to stop. Then the next person can come up and draw three straight lines, and stop, and so on, until you guess what they're drawing.

Do This: Show the drawers one of the Pictionary cards, and let them draw! When the audience guesses what they are drawing, you can select three new kids to draw so everyone gets a turn.

The Point: All of us do things a little differently from others. That's part of the way God made us! He made all of us to think differently and see things a little differently. That's why we can learn so much from each other!
