Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Humility Story Page

1. Time to Talk

Look Up and Read: Ephesians 4:2 and Luke 14:1 and verses 7-11. These verses are about being humble instead of prideful.

Discussion Questions:

- Have you ever had to help someone who was younger than you? If so, what did you do? How did you feel?
- How do you feel when you talk to someone who seems to only care about themselves? How should we treat someone who behaves like that? (Be patient, listen, and be kind.)
- What do you think being “humble” means? Do you think being humble is easy, or hard?
- What are some examples of people not being humble? What would the humble thing be to do in those examples?

Ask: What is going great right now? Is there something that’s not going great right now?

Pray: Talk to God, mentioning things the kids talked about if appropriate.

2. Activity

Do This: Read through the “Humility Story Page,” talking about ways you might respond to each of the situations. Discuss how each response listed on the page might be humble or prideful, and how you think it would affect the situation.

The Point: We can choose to have humility, even when we feel like we’re important, we know something already, or that we’re too good for something. Humility could mean listening, having a good attitude, or being willing to help others.
