Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Forgiveness Scenario Page

1. Activity

Say This: Have you ever had to forgive someone? It can be a challenge. Sometimes, forgiveness can be as simple as saying “I forgive you.” We can also show forgiveness by other the things we say and do, though. In this activity, I’m going to read out a story, and your job is to think of three ways one person in that story could show they forgive the other person.

Do This: Read each of the “forgiveness scenarios.” Talk about three ways the person in that scenario could forgive. Suggestions and ideas are provided with the scenarios.

The Point: Forgiveness isn’t just something we say, it’s something we do. And we forgive because God showed us what it looks like, by forgiving us!

2. Discussion Time

Look Up and Read: Ephesians 4:32. This verse tells us why we forgive others.

Discussion Questions:

- What do you think it means to “forgive” someone? (You could encourage kids to think about forgiveness as choosing to not be angry at someone.)
- Have you ever forgiven someone? What did you do?
- How do you think Blake is feeling? What would you tell him he should do?

Ask: How is this week going for you? Is there anything you want God’s help with?

Pray: Talk to God, including relevant things mentioned in your discussion.
