MINUTES EAGLE BROOK CHURCH ANNUAL MEETING July 28, 2019, 6:30 p.m.

Following a brief reception, the Annual Meeting for Eagle Brook Church for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 convened on Sunday, July 28, 201 at the Blaine campus.

Welcome and Opening Prayer

Travis Scharn, Blaine Campus Pastor, welcomed everyone to the meeting. Travis shared a baptism story his wife & her whole family (from in state & out of state) all were baptized this summer together. It was a reminder, that's why we do what we do – because we believe a life transforming relationship with Jesus is what we need. Travis opened the meeting by leading in prayer.

Call to Order

Dave Stead, Chair, called the meeting to order at 6:40 pm. He thanked everyone for coming.

Dave explained the procedures for the meeting, citing that only members of Eagle Brook Church are welcome to vote, and all others are welcome to participate in discussion. Dave referred to and reviewed the meeting packet and materials.

Meeting Minutes

- ♦ <u>Action:</u> Dave Stead called for review and approval of the July 28, 2019 Annual Meeting Minutes for Eagle Brook Church and invited any revisions. Hearing none, Dave called for a motion to approve the minutes.
- ♦ The motion was moved by Jolene Whicker and seconded by Pat Pike. The motion was approved unanimously.

Ministry Report

Tyler Gregory, Executive Pastor, thanked everyone for coming to the meeting, serving and giving. 'Tonight is a night for celebrating what God has done through Eagle Brook – we are so grateful.' Tyler thanked the staff, board and membership for their work.

In the 2018-2019 ministry year, Tyler shared the BHAG from 2 years ago that we set two years ago for 10,000 people to give their lives to Jesus. We accomplished that! This year alone we had 6,001 people give their lives to Jesus- the goal was 5,045. Up 37% over the previous year. 22,211 avg attendance on the weekend. This is a 0% increase but because of the Blaine expansion closing for 17 weeks the number did not increase. Online church has been an average of 13,331, up 18% this year. 1806 people baptized. (This does not include the 1147 just baptized this summer!)

Groups – 8.153 participants Serving – 9,126 Generosity – 2,635 households giving \$5,000 + Spend time with God- read your Bible plan that we offer – 3,047

Tyler introduced Dale Peterson, Executive Director of EBA. Dale outlined the wins that have been happening in the EBA. This is a ministry of Eagle Brook. Let's help other churches increase their numbers of salvations. 18,965 people gave their lives to Jesus through this outreach! It is now over 19,000 people.

Timothy Iniative in India received \$220,000 gift to the project that they are doing from the Heaven on Earth campaign.

People all over coming together to watch EBC online. Winwood, MN example of people coming together to buy a bar & start a church all together.

Since the EBA began 83,509 people have come to faith through other churches that we mentor.

Dale introduced Gari Pisca, Executive Director of Operations. Gari outlined all areas of Operation (HR, Finance, Facilities, Information Systems, Technology, Expansion).

Expansion

Gari explains the Blaine expansion – relaunch Dec 2018. 850 seats to 1500 in the auditorium. New lobby & Kid o deo. 670 people gave their lives to Jesus at this campus alone. \$356,000 under budget

Lakeville- 8th campus April 14. Lakeville S High School. Helping complete the 20-minute vision. Pictures of how the service comes together. 100 decisions to follow Jesus in just 6 weeks of operation

Rochester- Oct 2019 Mayo Center Launch pics to show how it will look. Presentation hall seats over 1,000 people.

West Metro Update- pursuing land in the 6-mile radius of area that we desire. We welcome your prayers as we aggressively pursue this. We are confident that He will bring the right pieces together.

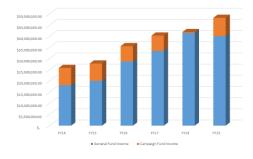

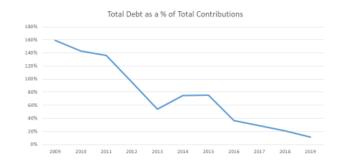

Dave introduced the board members: Dean Hager, Penny Hegseth, Al Holland, Debbie Matteoni, Jim VanDrasek, Merlin Satrom, Bob Merritt. Scott R and Peter Winter serving on Nominating Committee. Dave gave an update on membership, stating there are 65 new members.

Dave acknowledges the over 250 staff members & has those present stands.

Ballots

Dave introduced the election ballot presented to the members by the Nominating Committee and cited those who are nominated for each open board position and for the two open Nominating Committee positions. Dave reminded members that for any nominations from the floor, a nominee's permission is required ahead of time. Dave read each nominee for the board positions and invited any nominations from the floor and there were no additional nominations as each call was closed. Dave then noted the nominees for each nominating committee position and invited any nominees from the floor, and there were no additional nominations.

♦ Motion: Dave Stead stated that if there is a call for a written vote for the election ballot, it will be honored, and there was none. Dave invited a motion for a voice vote to approve the entire election ballot for board members and nominating committee members as presented. Motion to consider the entire ballot as presented by voice vote was moved by Lauren Advick and seconded by Bob Rowe. Upon calling for the vote by hand to accept the Election Ballot as presented in its entirety, the hand vote to approve was unanimous. Dave declared the ballot approved:

2019-2020 Proposed Budget and Vote

Julie referred to the Annual Planning Financial sheet and side screens to present the proposed fiscal year 2019-2020 budget.

General Fund Income

• 2020 \$42,000,000; projected increase of 4.7%

Personnel/Human Resources Expense

• 2020 \$19,800,000; 47.1% of contributions

Ministry & Operating Expense

• 2020 \$11,234,000; 26.7% of contributions

The increase in personnel is caused by a modest merit increase for staff (2.5-3%) and planning for expansion (Rochester, plus West Metro build). Julie asks for questions on the proposed budget.

- Motion: Dave read the motion from the Eagle Brook Church Board for membership approval of the Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget of \$42,000,000. Motion for voice vote.
 Moved by Rob Van Dressek, seconded by Linda B. The motion was unanimously approved.
- ♠ Motion: Articles & Bylaw and Constitutional changes up for a vote- presented by Gari Pisca & Dave. Bylaw changes- Gari notes the document that explains the changes that we need to make. Opens floor to Q's. We do have the 10% needed for this vote present. 268 members are present. Written ballot. Christopher Millow motion, Kevin Koske second. The motion was unanimously approved.
- ♦ <u>Motion:</u> Constitution change vote- mailing of ballot will be sent out following this meeting. Dan Nelson approves, Second Jennifer M. The motion was unanimously approved.

Senior Pastor's Report

Senior Pastor Bob Merritt thanked Dave & his wife Cathy for their work on the board.

Bob had a few words that came to him when thinking of this meeting- gratefulness in what God continues to do with this church. He is grateful that God has allowed him to be a part of this. Gearhart P – 93 years old this week! Celebrated him & the time that he & Bob had a big snowstorm at WBL. Virginia Woodbury 91 years old this week- such an encourager. Gwen Floerke- oldest members of our church. Barb Merrit 89 years old. All drove here & all pray for our church.

Wayzata land Lakeville – could be our biggest campus Rochester
