Discussion Questions

- 3. **Read Isaiah 6.** As you think about praying, "Send me," what fears or worries arise?
- 4. **Read Colossians 3:17.** God often sends us right where he's already placed us. What makes you uniquely qualified for being sent to your home, workplace, or community?

If you are willing to pray, God will answer. This week, commit to praying, "Here I am, send me," every day. Then, write down the people God puts on your heart throughout the week and look for opportunities to show them his love and grace.
