Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Ball

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a “thumbs up” when they are ready to listen.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- What are some things we can share? (Toys, games)
- What did the boy in our Bible Adventure share with Jesus? (His food- fish and bread)

Repeatable Phrases: “A good friend shares.” “I can be a good friend and family member.”

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Pass a ball around the circle. When someone has the ball, they get to say their name! Then pass the ball around again and have them say their favorite food.

Say This: You had to take turns and share the ball for that game. That is such an important part of being a good friend.

The Point: Sharing is a great way to be kind to others. When we share things like toys and games, it helps everyone to have fun!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Proverbs 17:17 - A friend loves at all times.

Big Idea: I can share.

Big Idea: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to share. Amen.”
