



## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song**

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

### **\_\_:25 Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

### **\_\_:35 Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# Group Time Guide

**Supplies Needed: None**

## 1. Snack

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

**Do This:** Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

## 2. Bible Story: The Good Samaritan

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Act it Out

**Do This:** After you've read the story, encourage Kid-Os to act out the story and do the actions listed along with you.

1. Say This: In our Bible Story, there was a man who was hurt. Can you show me a sad, hurt face? (Make a sad face with the Kid-Os.)
2. Then, a Samaritan came riding along the path. Can you pretend you're riding a donkey? (Bounce up and down with the Kid-Os.)
3. The Samaritan helped the man! He was very kind. Can you give yourself a big hug? (Give yourself a hug with the Kid-Os.)

**The Point:** God loves every person on earth, so He wants us to be happy to help others and be kind to them!

## 4. Prayer

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be kind. Amen."
