



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: The Good Samaritan

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Act it Out

Do This: After you've read the story, encourage Kid-Os to act out the story and do the actions listed along with you.

1. Say This: In our Bible Story, there was a man who was hurt. Can you show me a sad, hurt face? (Make a sad face with the Kid-Os.)
2. Then, a Samaritan came riding along the path. Can you pretend you're riding a donkey? (Bounce up and down with the Kid-Os.)
3. The Samaritan helped the man! He was very kind. Can you give yourself a big hug? (Give yourself a hug with the Kid-Os.)

The Point: God loves every person on earth, so He wants us to be happy to help others and be kind to them!

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be kind. Amen."
