



Open with Play Time

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

__:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

__:25 Group Time

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

__:35 Coloring

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

End with Play Time

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Snack

Circle Up: Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Bible Story: Mary Listens

Do This: Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

3. Hands-On Option: Listening Practice

Do This: Have everyone close their eyes while you walk around the room. Make different noises, like rolling a car, knocking on the door, jumping, or turning the doorknob. As you make noises, let the kids guess what you are doing, just by listening!

The Point: That took some careful listening. We can listen carefully to other people, too. Listening carefully helps us understand what they mean.

4. Prayer

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to listen. Amen.”
