



## **Open with Play Time**

Welcome each Kid-O into the room as they arrive. Help them find a toy or game to encourage engagement during play time.

### **\_\_:20 Music & Worship: Pick a song**

Have Kid-Os use scarves, ribbons, or instruments as you lead them in singing. Encourage the Kid-Os to use their hands, feet, and voices as they worship God!

### **\_\_:25 Group Time**

Follow the Group Time Guide on the next page.

### **\_\_:35 Coloring**

Hand out the Bible story coloring sheets and coloring utensils. Encourage the Kid-Os to color a picture to take home!

## **End with Play Time**

Allow the Kid-Os to play or color until they are picked up. Before each Kid-O leaves match their name tag to the grown-up's security tag.



# Group Time Guide

**Supplies Needed: None**

## 1. Snack

**Circle Up:** Have all Kid-Os sit in one section of the room for story time.

**Do This:** Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

## 2. Bible Story: Abigail is Peaceful

**Do This:** Read through the Bible Story at least one time. If Kid-Os are engaged, feel free to read it a second time.

## 3. Hands-On Option: Practice Peace

**Say This:** Being peaceful means being calm and kind, like Abigail was.

**Do This:** Tell Kid-Os that you're all going to be as quiet as you can for ten seconds. Give them a countdown- 3... 2... 1... Quiet!

**Do This:** Have Kid-Os repeat the following sentences after you, but they must use their quiet, peaceful voices. "I can be peaceful." "God loves me." "I can use kind words."

**The Point:** You can be peaceful by using your quiet, indoor voices. Another great way to share peace is by forgiving someone when they do something wrong. That's what Abigail helped King David do!

## 4. Prayer

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be peaceful. Amen."
