

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: Have Kid-Os sit down in a circle as quickly as they can and give you a "thumbs up" when they are ready to listen. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- What does "Faithfulness" mean? (Doing what's right, even when no one is watching.)
- Who was faithful to God in our Bible Adventure story? (Joseph)

Repeatable Phrases: "I can be faithful." "God cares about me."

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Play "Follow the Leader!" Walk around the room and have the Kid-Os follow you, doing whatever you do. You could walk slowly, hop, slide, jump, spin, duck, dance, and do other actions you think of! It is probably a good idea to tell kids what you are about to do before you do it, so they know what is coming.

If you have too many kids to move around the room, you may have them follow you while sitting/standing in place. They could sit or stand, jump, clap, spin, make a face, crouch down, dance, and other in-place actions you can think of!

The Point: Being faithful to God means doing the things he would do. We can find out the things God says are right by learning from the Bible!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

Memory Verse: Galatians 5:22- But the fruit the Holy Spirit produces is love, joy, and peace. It is being patient, kind, and good. It is being faithful and gentle and having control of oneself.

Big Idea: I can do what God says is right.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to do what you say is right. Amen.
