

Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Peace Picture Cards

1. Introductions and Snack

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say "hi" to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name.

Do This: Give kids hand sanitizer, then hand each of them a snack.

2. Discussion Questions

- What does the word "peace" mean? (Quiet, calm, everything's ok.)
- Who helped everyone be peaceful in our Bible Adventure story? (Abigail)

3. Hands-On Option

Do This: Show kids each of the "Peace Picture Cards" one at a time. Talk about why the thing shown in that picture is peaceful or not peaceful.

The Point: Every one of us can share the fruit of peace with others by using peaceful words and actions. When we are peaceful, we help others be peaceful, too!

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, Stickers, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: Galatians 5:22- But the fruit the Holy Spirit produces is love, joy, and peace. It is being patient, kind, and good.

Big Idea: I can be peaceful.

Do This: Give each kid a sticker. Encourage them to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to be peaceful. Amen.
