2. Did you do anything fun with the nice days we had this past week?

What are we talking about this week:

This week we are continuing our series called *Different Together*. This week's big truth is that everyone who trusts Jesus as their savior and leader becomes a member of God's family. This week is a decision message! Check in to see if any of your students chose to put their faith and CELEBRATE, ENCOURAGE, and PRAY for them! Then be sure to let your student pastor know!

1. If you met someone brand new and found out you had THIS in common, there'd be a good chance you'd end up friends. What would THIS be for you?
2. Read Ephesians 1:4-7. What does it mean to be a part of God's family? How does someone become a member of God's family? (Look back to the big truth!)
3. Read Galatians 3:26. Is it important to see ourselves as a child of God? Why or why not? Is it important to see other Christians that way? What could this change if we did?
4. What is an inheritance? What would be one thing you'd love to inherit? But you can't say money!
5. Read Ephesians 1:11. What are some of the things we inherit as the children of God? Do you have any questions about what Jesus did for you or how you can become a part of God's family?

Now what:

If we are the children of God, then other Christians are our brothers and sisters in Jesus Christ! How can we start to treat other Christians more like family this week?
