What are we talking about this week?

This week we're kicking off a new series called, *All God Wants for Christmas*. Getting gifts is an exciting part of the Christmas season, and we spend a lot of time thinking about what we want. But how often do we take time to ask what God might want from us? In this series, we'll take the focus off of ourselves and talk about all God wants for Christmas. This week's message is about how we can give God **GLORY** by telling others what he has done for us and by worshiping him!

Read Luke 2:8-20

1. What do you think of when you hear the word glory? What is interesting to you about this story? Was anything surprising?
2. What are some ways we can give God glory or show others how awesome he is? How did the shepherds give God glory in this story?
3. We give God glory when we tell others what he has done for us. What did God do for the shepherds? What was so amazing about it? What are some things that God has done for you? Who could you tell about it?
4. We give God glory when we worship him. What are some of your favorite worship songs? How does singing worship songs give God glory? What are some ways you can worship God this week?

Now what?

Make a worship list! Make a list of all the reasons God deserves your worship this Christmas season. Write down the things he has done for you. Write down things about God that are awesome. Write down things you are thankful for, ways that God has blessed you.

Then, take time this week to worship God because of who he is and what he has done for you. Go tell somebody about the things you wrote down, so other people can be amazed by what God has done for you, and he will get even more glory!
