



## **Group Time Guide**

Supplies Needed: Christmas Invitations

## 1. Time to Talk

**Look Up and Read**: Isaiah 9:6-7. This is something Isaiah wrote about Jesus, long before Jesus was born.

## **Discussion Questions:**

- What is God saying through Isaiah there in those verses? What is exciting about what Isaiah is saying?
- How is Isaiah describing Jesus in these verses?
- Who is someone you could tell about God or invite to our Christmas services?

**Ask**: How is the start to the school year going for you? Is there anything you would like God's help with right now?

**Pray**: Talk to God, mentioning relevant things that came up in your discussion.

## 2. Activity

**Discuss**: "Prophets" and prophecy is all about telling the truth about God and the way He made us. Have you ever had a situation where telling the truth was a challenge?

**Say This**: One true thing God wants us to tell everyone is that He loves them and wants them to know Him. We can do that this Christmas in a cool way!

**Do This**: Give each kid an invitation and encourage them to fill it out. While they are working, talk about the following questions.

**Discuss**: Can you think of a time you were invited to something, and now you really like going to that thing? (Church, sports team, music group)

**Discuss**: Who are some people we could invite to come to church this Christmas? (Family, friends, people at school.)

Discuss: If someone asked you what you like about church, what would you tell them?

**The Point**: God wants everyone to know about Him, and about how much He loves them! We have a great chance to tell people about God this Christmas by sharing hope, like Isaiah did, and by inviting people to come to church with us.
