In this series, we'll learn about some of the gifts God gives us, whether they're things we can enjoy every day or in special circumstances.

Lesson 1: November 6/7 - Leadership

Aren't you glad we don't go through life all alone? This week, we'll learn about the people God has given us who help us learn and grow.

Lesson 2: November 13/14 - Mercy

Most of us like receiving generous gifts, but how do we feel about giving to others? This week, we'll talk about what it means to show kindness to others even when we don't have to.

Lesson 3: November 20/21 - Wisdom

Sometimes life can be confusing. Thankfully, God is with us! This week, we'll talk about how God gives us guidance when we're not sure what we should do.

Lesson 4: November 27/28 - Languages

Have you ever felt left out when someone gets a gift that you didn't? This week, we'll talk about how God wants to give the gift of His Spirit and connect with <u>all</u> of us, no matter where we come from or what language we speak.

Lesson 5: December 4/5 - Encouragement

While big gifts usually get our attention, it's the personal gifts that often mean the most. This week, we'll see that while God can do spectacular miracles, He can also do awe-inspiring things through us in everyday moments when we show kindness and help one another.

Lesson 6: December 11/12 - Prophecy

It's exciting to get a delivery, isn't it? There's something special about someone bringing us something that's addressed to us. This week, we'll talk about what it means to look forward to what God is sending our way, and how we can serve as messengers to deliver what God wants to offer to other people.

Lesson 7: December 18/19 - Evangelism

It can feel hard to know how to talk about Jesus with others sometimes. This week, we'll talk about what leads us to tell other people about what God has done in our lives and our world.

Lesson 8: Christmas Week

The greatest gift that God has ever given us is His son, Jesus. God sent Jesus into the world to rescue us and make a way for us to have a relationship with Him. This week, we'll hear the story of Christmas and discover why Jesus came.

Opening Song and Welcome



Do This: During the song, encourage kids to find a place to sit, and let them know it's time to get started.


Welcome everyone, let's get started! I'm so glad you're all here! Come on up and find a place to sit.

Team Time 14:00



Today we are in a series called "Gifts that Keep on Giving." Gifts are awesome, right? When someone gives us a gift, especially a really great gift, that is super exciting! In this series, we're going to be talking about some gifts that God Himself gives us. The thing to remember is, God doesn't just give us these gifts for ourselves, He wants us to share them with others, too!

Let's get started with a game called "Bow on Top."



In this game, one person in your group will be sitting on the floor blindfolded. Your goal is to set a bow on their head or one of their shoulders without them knowing where you set it. Your group leader will give you each a gift bow, and you'll take turns trying to set your bow on the person on the ground.

If you are the person on the ground, after they put the bow on you, you will have one chance to say whether you think it is on your head or shoulder. If you are right, you switch places with the person who placed their bow. If you are wrong, you stay there and stay blindfolded.

Ready? Go and find your groups!




Fun Game Music!

Game Title Slide: "Bow on Top" and clear audio

Let's get ready to answer our question of the day.



(Auto Advance) QOTD Slide: How have you seen someone show "mercy"?

Our question today is: How have you seen someone show "mercy"? Mercy can mean being kind to someone else, even if they haven't earned it or don't really deserve it, or taking it easy on someone who is having a tough time. Is there a story you think of about mercy? Turn to someone near you and tell them about it! Make sure to listen to their answer, too.

Do This: Allow kids to talk for about 30 seconds.

Know This: You can share your answer briefly, too!


Series Title Slide: Gifts that Keep on Giving


Do This: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to discuss the question.


That looked like a fun activity. Let's keep on learning about mercy with the Elevate Show!
