Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: Gift Bag with Different Items

1. Introductions

Circle Up: As you come into the room, have Kid-Os say “hi” to someone else in the circle as they sit down. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer. Then pass out a snack to each child who is able to have one.

2. Discussion Questions

- What did God want Moses to do in our Bible Adventure story? (God wanted Moses to rescue God's people from Egypt.)

Repeatable Phrases: “God has a purpose for me.” “I can share God's love with others.”

3. Hands-On Option

Say This: We're going to play a game called “What's the Purpose?” Purpose means what something does or what it was made for. I'm going to pull an item out of this bag and we have to guess what the purpose of the item is.

Do This: Pull each item out of the bag one at a time. Ask kids what the item is and then ask them what it was made to do.

The Point: God gives each one of us a special purpose. God made each one of us with different gifts and talents that will help us love God and love other people well.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: **Memory Verse:** James 1:17 – “Every good and perfect gift is from God.”

Big Idea: God gives me purpose.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! “Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Thank you for giving each one of us a purpose. Amen.”
