# Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: None

## 1. Introductions

**Circle Up:** Have the Kid-Os wave at each other and then sit down in a circle.

Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you give them hand sanitizer. Then pass out a snack to each child who is able to have one.

## 2. Discussion Questions

- What did Abraham do in our Bible Adventure story that showed faith? (He followed God's directions and went to a brand new land.)
- What does it mean to have "faith"? (To trust God and believe that what God says is true.)

## 3. Hands-On Option

**Say This:** Abraham had faith by following God's directions, even though he couldn't see what was going to happen next or where God was leading him. In this game, I need all of you to stand up and close your eyes. I'm going to give you directions and I want you to follow them, even though you can't see.

**Do This:** Play the "Following the Leader" game with the Kid-Os. Give these directions: stomp your feet, turn around slowly, touch your toes, take two steps forward, jump up and down, take one step backwards, wave your hands in the air.

**The Point:** One of God's gifts to us is faith. With faith, we can trust God and believe that what he says is true.

## 4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

**Do This:** Practice the Big Idea and Memory Verse with the kids.

**Memory Verse:** James 1:17 – "Every good and perfect gift is from God."

**Big Idea:** God gives me faith.

**Do This:** Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

**Do This:** Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to put our faith in you. Amen."
