General Personal Expectations for Group Leaders

- Be an owner by living out Eagle Brook's five values (Follow Jesus, Spend Time with God, Connect in Community, Serve Others, and Live Generously) as you move toward becoming a member, if not one already.
- Be committed to growing in wisdom, character and obedience.
- Serve for a minimum of one group session (Fall/Winter/Spring).
- Be committed to growing as a leader by attending meetings with pastors, leader trainings, and seeking out leader development opportunities.
- Take attendance after each group meeting (using MyEBC and/or the LEAD app)
- Build relationships within the group by staying in touch with group members throughout the week.
- Pray for your group members on a regular basis.

- Be wise on social media-since you will be a representative of Eagle Brook Church.
