Lesson 1: Why doesn't God give me what I pray for right now?

Prayer is amazing- we get to talk to the God who made the universe! If God is so powerful, though, why doesn't he always give us what we ask for? This week, we'll see why when God says "wait," or even says "no," it might be a good thing.

Lesson 2: Why does God let bad things happen?

Life can feel unfair sometimes. Why did someone else get what I wanted? Why did I get sick the day before the big game? In Job, one of the oldest books of the Bible, we hear the story of someone who lost everything, and see God actually tell Job about why bad things can happen.

Lesson 3: What is heaven like?

In heaven, we won't play music on harps, won't sit on clouds, and won't even have wings or halos. So, what is heaven really like? This week, we'll learn about heaven from someone who has been there-Jesus himself!

Lesson 4: Why should I read the Bible?

Why do we follow what a book that is thousands of years old says? How do we know that the Bible is true? This week, we'll discover why we can trust the Bible to guide us and help us learn about God today.

Lesson 5: Can I be friends with someone when we disagree?

Sometimes, we all disagree, even with our best friends! This week, we'll learn how we can still be friends with someone, even when we don't see things the way they do.

Lesson 6: Why does what I watch matter?

We watch so many things, from slow-motion videos to YouTube celebrities to our favorite shows on Netflix. This week, we're asking the question: does what we watch matter? Join us as we discover how what we watch can change who we become.

Lesson 7: How do I know God's purpose for me?

God made you for an amazing purpose! The question is: what is it? Why don't we get a step-by-step instruction guide for living out God's purpose for our lives? This week, we'll see how Peter, one of Jesus' closest friends, discovered God's purpose for him in an incredible way.

Series Title Slide: Got Questions? and clear audio

Have you ever wished we could ask God questions, and get some answers? If so, this series is just right for you! We've taken some of the biggest questions people ask about God, Jesus, church, and life, and we're ready to answer them!

Do This: Make sure each kid finds their group. Help group leaders if there is a need. Encourage kids as they work to answer the question.

Know This: This is a time for kids to search for answers in the Bible and see how they can use the Bible to investigate and better understand life. This time is designed for kids to interact and deepen their understanding. They won't get all the answers but allow them to question and discover as much as possible. Be ready to support group leaders in any way needed.

Do This: Give the groups a warning about one minute before this time is up.

Bad things happen to all of us. It can be hard to understand why sometimes, but we can always know God cares, even when life is tough.

Here's what I want you to remember today.

We can trust God when we are hurting.

We can trust God when we are hurting. Sometimes bad things happen. Sometimes we feel hurt or afraid, and sometimes we just don't understand why something had to happen the way it did. The truth is, we won't be able to completely understand why every bad thing in the world has happened. I can't explain every single one of them, but we can choose to trust God no matter what happens, like Job did.

This is such a big and important question for us to think about. Let's think about what we can learn from Job's story, and the Source team's story.



1. God has a plan for you. (And clay image)

The first thing to remember is that God has a plan for you. Even when we don't understand what is happening, we can have hope, and remember that God is still in charge, and working everything toward an amazing goal. One example that we find in another place in the Bible is of someone who makes pottery out of clay, like this picture.

Sometimes going through difficult things can help us grow and even make us stronger. <u>Check</u> out what this verse says.



James 1:3- Your faith will be tested. You know that when this happens it will produce in you the strength to continue.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

What the writer here is saying is like what Job learned. When we go through tough things, they can make us stronger. God can use those things to help us grow.

Clay Image

This lump of clay doesn't look beautiful, strong, or useful. At least, not yet. If you were making something out of clay, you'd have to pull on it, push it with your fingers, and mold it into what you wanted it to look like. God does something like that with every one of us. If we choose to trust God, each thing that happens to us can help us become who he's making us to be, even if it's difficult.

- 1. God has a plan.
- 2. Difficult things can help us grow. (And kiln image)

The second thing we've learned today is that difficult things can help us grow. When life gets tough, that's a chance for us to learn and trust God more. In The Source, we saw how Trixie became more brave and confident through her mom being sick.

It's still like the way pottery is made. After someone molds the clay, it's still soft. It doesn't become rock hard pottery until it goes into an oven, like the one on the screen. Putting the clay into an oven makes it tougher and stronger. If they didn't put clay into an oven, it'd be ok to look at, but it wouldn't be as strong as clay that has been in an oven. That oven takes the clay and turns it into a piece of pottery.

Complete pottery Image

Just like that, difficult things, times that feel like we're hurting or "in a fire," can work like that clay oven, and help us become stronger. When we choose to trust God, even when life is difficult, those tough things can change us, help us learn, and help us become better. We saw the difference that made in Trixie's life.

Like I said, we won't be able to understand every bad thing that has ever happened, but we can trust God no matter what. God has a plan and purpose for you. He loves you

and is always with you. No matter what happens, good or bad, we can keep trusting and following God.
