Lesson 1: Why doesn't God give me what I pray for right now?

Prayer is amazing- we get to talk to the God who made the universe! If God is so powerful, though, why doesn't he always give us what we ask for? This week, we'll see why when God says "wait," or even says "no," it might be a good thing.

Lesson 2: Why does God let bad things happen?

Life can feel unfair sometimes. Why did someone else get what I wanted? Why did I get sick the day before the big game? In Job, one of the oldest books of the Bible, we hear the story of someone who lost everything, and see God actually tell Job about why bad things can happen.

Lesson 3: What is heaven like?

In heaven, we won't play music on harps, won't sit on clouds, and won't even have wings or halos. So, what is heaven really like? This week, we'll learn about heaven from someone who has been there-Jesus himself!

Lesson 4: Why should I read the Bible?

Why do we follow what a book that is thousands of years old says? How do we know that the Bible is true? This week, we'll discover why we can trust the Bible to guide us and help us learn about God today.

Lesson 5: Can I be friends with someone when we disagree?

Sometimes, we all disagree, even with our best friends! This week, we'll learn how we can still be friends with someone, even when we don't see things the way they do.

Lesson 6: Why does what I watch matter?

We watch so many things, from slow-motion videos to YouTube celebrities to our favorite shows on Netflix. This week, we're asking the question: does what we watch matter? Join us as we discover how what we watch can change who we become.

Lesson 7: How do I know God's purpose for me?

God made you for an amazing purpose! The question is: what is it? Why don't we get a step-by-step instruction guide for living out God's purpose for our lives? This week, we'll see how Peter, one of Jesus' closest friends, discovered God's purpose for him in an incredible way.

Know This: This is a time for kids to search for answers in the Bible and see how they can use the Bible to investigate and better understand life. Be ready to support group leaders in any way needed.

Got Questions? Lesson 7 April 4/5 11 We can always trust God to guide us. Like Peter learned, God's purpose for our lives isn't a place that we get to, but a part of our whole journey. Along that whole journey, we can trust that God is the perfect guide.



Marathon Image

You could think about it like this. In a few places in the Bible, people say life is like a race. The people in this picture are running a long race, a marathon. It's over twentysix miles long. If you ran a marathon, you might take something like fifty thousand steps in that one race. That is a ton of steps. In fact, look at this picture.



50,000 dots image.

There are 50,000 dots in this picture, each one represents a step in a marathon. Here's my question for you, though. You don't have to answer me out loud, just think about it. Which one of those steps is most important? Can you skip one step of the race? Could a racer just hop in a car for a hundred steps, and then run the rest of the race? Of course not! Every single step is part of the race. You can't have the last step without the first step, and the second step, and the twenty-five thousand four hundred and fifty fifth step. Every one of them is part of the race.

So, if life is like a race, is there a part of it that doesn't matter? Can we say "I'll trust God and follow him at church, but at school I'll take a break from following God"? Of course not! Every step in your life matters. The race isn't about crossing the finish line, it's about running every step faithfully. A runner's purpose isn't just to cross a line, but to run the whole race.



Series Title Slide: Got Questions?

God's purpose for our lives isn't something we'll discover in the future, but something we're living in right now. God isn't waiting by the finish line; he's running this race with you. God is with you right now, leading you and guiding you.

So when we say we can trust God, it's because no matter what happens to us, he still has an amazing purpose for us. We find that purpose by following him through every

part of our lives, the easy steps, the hard steps, and the steps where we just feel like giving up. We can trust God through every step of life.
