Supplies Needed: True or False Bible Questions list

1. Time to Talk

Look Up and Read: John 14:6-7 and Ephesians 6:14. These verses are both about how important it is to believe what's true.

- When is a time it might be difficult to know what is true? (When two of our friends are arguing, when one person says one thing and another says something different).
- What did Josh do that got him into this tough spot? (Lied about being in a rodeo.) What do you think Josh should do about his problem?
- Have you ever argued with someone, like Beka's doing? How do you think Emma will feel if Beka keeps on trying to prove her wrong? Do you think Beka is right?

Ask: What is something going great right now? What is something that is difficult right now?

Pray: Talk to God, mentioning relevant things that came up in your discussion.

2. Activity

Do This: Read the list of "True or False Bible Questions." Have the kids stand up if they think the "fact" is true and sit if they think it is false. Have fun!

The Point: It's not always easy to know what is true and what isn't. God gave us the Bible to help us know what is true and make wise choices.
