Big Idea: I can ask God for help.

Question to Ask: What can you ask God to help you with today?

May 25/26: Saying Thanks

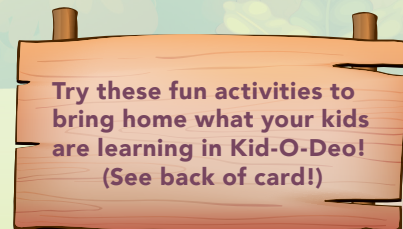
Look It Up: Luke 17:12-19

Big Idea: I can thank God.

Question to Ask: What are three things you can thank God for?

Memory Verse:

Morning Time: Talk to God while you're eating breakfast. Pray and ask God to help you follow Him and make wise choices throughout the day!



Drive Time: Look out the window and notice things that you are thankful for. Maybe you'll see some beautiful flowers that remind you to thank God for creating the world and the amazing things in it. Or maybe you'll drive by a school and thank God for giving us minds that can learn and think!



Play Time: Play "Simon Says" as a family. Discuss how important it is to listen to "Simon" so you are sure to only do what "Simon" says to do. Then talk about how we can listen to God and follow His instructions for us too!



Learning Time: Plant one or more items in a pot or even in your own garden. Learn about what you're planting and discuss what you can do to help your plant grow strong. Just like water and sunshine can help plants grow, prayer can help us grow with God!



Bed Time: Pray to God together. Thank God for the good things He's given you and talk to Him about anything that you'd like. God already knows what's on our mind, but spending time talking to God will help us grow in our friendship with Him!
