Group Time Guide

Supplies Needed: The Beginner's Bible

1. Introductions

Circle Up: As you come into the room, give each Kid-O hand sanitizer and have them sit in a circle. Encourage each Kid-O to say their name as you pass out a snack to everyone who can have one.

2. Discussion Questions

- What book did God tell Joshua to read in our Bible Adventure story? (The Bible)
- Why is it important to read the Bible? (To learn more about God)

Repeatable Phrase: "I can learn about God."

3. Hands-On Option

Say This: Let's read a story from this Bible and see what we can learn about God.

Do This: Read "Daniel and the Lions" from The Beginner's Bible on page 251. Then ask these questions:

- Why wasn't Daniel afraid when he was thrown into the lions' den? (He knew God would take care of him.)
- What does this story teach us about God? (God is powerful, God takes care of us, etc.)

The Point: One way we can spend time with God and get to know him better is by reading the Bible. God loves us so much and we can learn more about Him each day.

4. Big Idea, Memory Verse, and Prayer

Do This: Practice the Memory Verse and the Big Idea with the kids.

Memory Verse: Colossians 1:10 – "We pray that you will grow to know God better." **Big Idea**: I can grow by learning about God.

Do This: Encourage kids to talk about what they learned with their grown-ups.

Do This: Pray! "Dear God, we love you. Thank you for loving us. Help us to keep learning about You. Amen."
