## Series at a Glance for Kid-O-Deo (continued)

#### Lesson 1: April 23/24

One of the ways we can grow in our faith is by living generously. This week, we'll hear the story of the boy who shared his lunch and discover that God can do big things when we share what we have!

#### Lesson 2: April 30/May 1

Spending time with God by praying is an important way we can grow closer to God. Daniel was a man who took time to pray every single day. When Daniel had a hard choice to make, he knew God was with him and would help him.

#### Lesson 3: May 7/8

God helps us grow closer to him through reading his words in the Bible. This week, we'll hear the story of Joshua as he was getting ready to lead God's people into the promised land. One of the important things God asked Joshua to do was keep reading the Bible.

#### Lesson 4: May 14/15

Serving can help us grow to be more like Jesus. We can serve in so many different ways! This week, we'll hear a story about how people in the church served others.

#### **Lesson 5: May 21/22**

We can grow closer to God by spending time worshipping him. This week, we'll hear the story of Paul and Silas and learn that we can worship God no matter what.

#### **Lesson 6: May 28/29**

Saul was hurting others and being unkind, but everything changed when he decided to follow Jesus. Saul grew into a person who loved and served others. He started telling everyone about how they could follow Jesus, too!

#### Lesson 7: June 4/5

One of the ways God helps us grow is by spending time with people who follow Jesus. The people in the first church spent a lot of time together learning about God, eating, sharing what they had, and encouraging each other. We can be part of a church community, too!

## **Introduction and Rules**

Welcome everyone! My name is \_\_\_\_\_, and I'm super excited to see each and every one of you! During our time together, we'll get to sing a couple fun songs, learn a memory verse, and hear an awesome story. Before we do any of that, there are three important things for you to remember.

**Know This**: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! On the count of three, let's practice our very best listening. Ready? 1, 2, 3!

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

Let's hold up our hands and wiggle our fingers! Now, give a little clap and put your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Great job listening to our rules. The rules are really great because they can help us learn and have lots of fun while we're here.


(Auto advance) Series Title Slide: Let's Grow!

Big Idea 2:00

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. We're in a series called "Let's Grow!" There are lots of different ways you can grow. You can grow taller, grow wiser, and grow by learning new things. In this series, we're talking about ways we can grow to know God better.

At our church, we talk about five important ways to grow closer to God. We call them our five values. Can you hold up five fingers and say, "five values?" The first value we're learning about is "Live Generously." That means sharing what we have.

To get started, we're going to practice our "Big Idea." That's the super important thing we're learning about today!



The Big Idea is, "I can grow by sharing." One way to grow to know God better is by sharing what we have. Let's stand up and practice the big idea. I'll say a part first and you can repeat after me. I can grow, I CAN GROW. By sharing, BY SHARING. Great job! Alright, now let's say it all together!

**Do This:** Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Quacking Duck, Roaring Lion, Baaing Sheep.** 

**Know This**: These are the Big Idea actions: (Place your hands in front of your face, palms out, then move them down in a rainbow motion) The Big Idea. (Point at self with thumbs) I can grow (Extend arms out with palms up) by sharing.

Now, we get to plant a seed and watch it grow throughout our time together! Can you pretend to take out a tiny seed? Now let's dig a hole in the dirt and plant our seed. Great job! I can't wait to see what it becomes!

**Do This:** Pick up the small seed and plant it in the pot. Have kids pretend to plant their own seed with you by pretending to dig a hole and put the seed in the dirt.

## Bible Adventure

5:00

Next, we get to learn more by going on a Bible Adventure.



Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories that can help us grow to know God better. Today, we get to read a story about a boy who shared what he had.

**Do This:** Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

**Do This:** Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.



Picture 1: A large crowd is all around Jesus.

One day, large crowds of people were following Jesus. They had seen some of his miracles, like healing people who were sick. As the crowd got closer, Jesus asked his disciples, "Where can we buy food to feed all of these people?"



Picture 2: Disciple points to a boy with bread and fish.

The crowd was huge with more than 5,000 people! The disciples didn't have enough money to feed all of them. What should they do? Then, one disciple said, "I see a boy over there with some food. He has five loaves of bread and two fish. But that won't be enough to feed everyone!"



Picture 3: Jesus holds the bread and fish and thanks God.

Jesus told the disciples to have everyone sit down on the grassy hill. Then, the boy shared his small lunch of bread and fish with Jesus. After Jesus thanked God for the food, something amazing happened!



Picture 4: Crowd eating on a hill. 12 baskets of food left.

As Jesus handed out the food, there was enough for all 5,000 people! There were even twelve baskets of food left over. Jesus was able to do this incredible miracle all because a boy was willing to share what he had.



Series Title Slide: Let's Grow!

Great listening, Kid-Os! I love that story because it reminds us that God can do big things when we share what we have.



Big Idea Flower and Sound

Oh, that's our Big Idea sound! Let's say our Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. I CAN GROW BY SHARING.

Great job Kid-Os! Now, it's time to water our seed. Can you pretend to take out a watering can? Now, let's pour some water on our seed!

**Do This:** Pick up watering can and pretend to pour water on the dirt in the pot. Have the kids pretend to do this with you.

Great! Now, let's watch our seed grow!





Tomato plant animation (grows up from pot)

Wow! I wonder what kind of plant it will be!

Now, we get to learn a memory verse all about growing closer to God.

**Do This:** Read the verse from the screen.

Kid-Os, our church's value of sharing what we have can help us grow to know God better. God gives us so much and wants us to share with others!

**Do This:** Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

**Know This**: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) Colossians 1:10 (Put hands together in a praying motion) We pray, (crouch down and jump up) that you will grow, (point at head with both hands) to know God better.
