Lesson 1: From Ordinary to Chosen

The disciples were all pretty ordinary people, but Jesus chose them to be some of his closest friends. This week, we'll hear the story of Matthew and how his life was forever changed when Jesus said "Come, follow me."

Lesson 2: From Hidden to Known

The woman at the well did not have a very good reputation with people in her village. She went to the well to get water at a time when others wouldn't be there. This week, we'll hear how Jesus meets the woman at the well and shows her that she is known and loved.

Lesson 3: From Fear to Faith

The disciples were traveling across the sea in a boat when all of a sudden there was a huge storm. They called out to Jesus and he calmed the wind and the waves. This week, we'll discover how this miracle helped the disciples understand that they could trust Jesus, even when they felt afraid.

Lesson 4: From Guilty to Forgiven

Some people thought that you shouldn't go near Jesus if you had done things that were wrong. This week, we'll hear a story about a sinful woman who showed extravagant love to Jesus and was told by Jesus she was forgiven.

Lesson 5: From Rejected to Valuable

Parents wanted to bring their children to see Jesus, but the disciples told them no. Children were not seen as important and the disciples didn't want them to bother Jesus with them. This week, we'll hear the story of how Jesus responds to the children and shows them how valuable they are.

Lesson 6: From Sadness to Joy

Jesus had just died on the cross and Mary Magdalene felt so much sadness. It wasn't supposed to end like this! Mary's sadness soon turned to joy when Jesus appeared to her in the garden and showed her that he was alive! All of us can have joy because Jesus is alive!

Lesson 7: From Proud to Purpose

Saul was proud of his ability to follow the rules, but he was very mean to the people who followed Jesus. Everything changed for Saul after he met Jesus. He went from being an enemy of Jesus to telling everyone he could about Jesus' story!

Introduction and Rules

Know This: This is a great opportunity to set the tone and expectations for your time together. Kids like to know what's expected of them too—it helps them feel safe and secure. You can make this section informative, helpful, and fun all at the same time!

Rule #1: When I'm talking you are listening!

Let's put on our listening ears and turn them way up! On the count of three, let's practice our very best listening. Ready? 1, 2, 3!

Rule #2: Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

We want this to be a great place for all you leaders and Kid-Os, which means no poking, kicking, or bugging your neighbor. A good way to remember this rule is to: do a little clap and place your hands in your lap!

Rule #3: Stay in your spot!

You have a spot of your very own here in Kid-O-Deo, and it's right where you are sitting! It's important for us to stay in our spots, so that everyone can pay attention and have fun!

Big Idea 2:00

I love singing with you, Kid-Os! You can sit down. We are in a series called "Made New." In springtime, so many different things are made new again. The leaves start to appear on trees, flowers bloom, and caterpillars transform into butterflies. This series is all about people who met Jesus and how their lives were transformed and made new.

During our time together, we are going to be looking for some envelopes around the room. Inside will be something in nature that is changing and being made new.

Let's get started by practicing our "Big Idea." That's the super important thing we're learning about today!



Big Idea Jingle



The Big Idea is, "Jesus will always forgive me." Let's stand up and practice the big idea. I'll say a part first and you can repeat after me. Jesus will, JESUS WILL. Always forgive me, ALWAYS FORGIVE ME. Great job! Alright, now let's say it all together!

Do This: Show Kid-Os the actions and have them practice the Big Idea with you three times. Use a different voice each time. **Voice ideas for this week: Laughing, sleepy, jumping. Know This:** These are the Big Idea actions: (Place your hands in front of your face, palms out, then move them down in a rainbow motion) The Big Idea. (Point up) Jesus will always, (point at self) forgive me.

Awesome job practicing our Big Idea! You can all sit down.

That Big Idea is so important, we're going to say it several times today. Whenever you hear this sound, it's time to say our big idea!



You can say it and still do the actions while sitting in your spot. Let's practice!

Series Title Slide: Made New

Now, let's see if we can find an envelope with a number one on it! Does anyone see it?

Do This: Walk around the stage pretending like you are searching for the envelope. Pretend you can't find it. Let the kids guide you to where it is located.

There it is! Let's open it and see what's inside.

Do This: Pull out card and stick it on square number one.

What do you think this is? Yes! It looks like an egg. Let's keep going and see how it changes during our time together.

Next, we get to learn more about how Jesus forgives us by going on a Bible Adventure.



Bible Adventure Jingle

Do This: Show kids the Bible.

The Bible is the greatest book ever. It's full of words from God, and there are lots of true stories about when Jesus lived on the earth, too! Today, we get to read a story about a woman who was forgiven by Jesus.

Do This: Get the Bible storybook out and sit down in the chair.

This story you are going to hear comes from the Bible, but we use this storybook because the pictures help us imagine what it might have looked like back when the Bible was written. The pictures you see in here are the same as the ones on the screen. Let's get started!

Do This: Have kids help you "turn" the pages on the screen with an exaggerated arm wave.




Picture 1: Jesus eating at the pharisee's house.

One day, a Pharisee named Simon invited Jesus to come over to his house for dinner. Pharisees were religious leaders who thought they were better than everyone else. While Jesus was there, a woman who had done a lot of wrong things showed up with a jar of expensive perfume.




Picture 2: Woman pouring perfume on Jesus' feet.

The woman knelt down and poured out the perfume on Jesus' feet. She was crying because she knew she had done wrong things and she was sorry. As her tears fell on Jesus' feet, she wiped them off with her hair. Simon thought, "If Jesus was really sent from God, he would know what kind of woman this is. She has done so many wrong things!"



Jesus knew what Simon was thinking, so he answered him with a story that helped him understand forgiveness better. "Imagine that a man let two people borrow some of his money. He gave one person 500 pieces of silver and the other person got 50 pieces of silver. Neither one of them could pay the man back so he decided to forgive them both and not make them pay. Which person do you think was more thankful?"



Simon answered, "I guess the man who owed more money was the most thankful." "That's right," Jesus said. "Simon, this woman has done many wrong things, but all of her sins have been forgiven. That's why she has shown me so much love and thankfulness by pouring perfume on my feet." Then Jesus said to the woman, "You can go, knowing that you are forgiven."



Great listening, Kid-Os! The woman's life was changed because Jesus forgave her for the wrong things she had done. Jesus will forgive each one of us, too! In fact, I think that's what our Big Idea is about.



Oh, that's our Big Idea sound! Let's say our Big Idea together. THE BIG IDEA. JESUS WILL ALWAYS FORGIVE ME.

Great job Kid-Os! Let's see if we can find envelope number two hiding somewhere up here. Can you help me find it?

Do This: Walk around the stage pretending like you are searching for the envelope. Let the kids guide you to where it is located.

There it is! Let's open it and see what's inside.

Do This: Pull out card and stick it on square number two.

It looks like the egg is starting to crack! I'm excited to see what happens!

Next, we get to learn a memory verse all about what happens in our lives when we follow Jesus.

(Auto-advance) Memory Verse: 2 Corinthians 5:17 – "When anyone lives in Christ, the new creation has come. The old is gone! The new is here!"

Our Memory Verse comes from the Bible. This one is all about how our life changes and is made new when we follow Jesus.

Do This: Read the verse from the screen.

When we decide to follow Jesus, one way we are made new is that we are forgiven. Jesus will forgive any wrong thing we do if we are sorry and ask him to forgive us.

Do This: Practice the verse with the Kid-Os three times. You can start in your quiet/whisper voice and then get a little louder each time you practice.

Know This: The verse with actions goes like this: (Open your Bibles) 2 Corinthians 5:17. (Point up) When anyone lives in Christ (point down) the new creation has come. (Palms down, sweeping motion back and forth) The old is gone! (Point at self with thumbs) The new is here!"

Super job practicing your Memory Verse, Kid-Os! Let's see if we can find envelope number three anywhere. Can you help me out? I don't see it!

Do This: Walk around the stage pretending like you are searching for the envelope. Let the kids guide you to where it is located.


There it is! Let's open it and see what's inside.

Do This: Walk around the stage pretending like you are searching for the envelope. Let the kids guide you to where it is located.

There it is! Let's open it and see what's inside.

Do This: Pull out card and stick it on square number four.

Wow! Look how this egg transformed into a yellow bird. That's amazing!
